	Windows Live Mesh provides cloud storage for your most important files. You can always chose an online storage space if you need some extra space. Another place you could back your work or information to is Windows 7 because it helps you chose which information you should back up or you can pick individual files yourself. Windows can back up the files with any schedule you choose. You could also back up the data to another drive or DVD. Another option is backing it up to a windows 7 network.
	You can keep your back ups secure by storing them in an online storage space. This way it keeps them safe and you won't lose them if they are saved on your hard disk in your computer just in case you get a virus or you accidentally delete them. Also your computer disk could just crash and then you might not get them back.
